




SETTING THE SCENE AND GETTING STARTED


• Phase 1: Research

- Collection of existing EU and US guidance for funding terms and glossaries that are CC
- Researching to appropriate platform
- Phase 2: Set-up of a MediaWiki
 - Concept and logic for using a Terminology MediaWiki
 - Definition of regulations regarding user rights, help function, etc.
- Phase 3: Transfer of data into the Terminology MediaWiki
 - Allocating each term to the respective "language" (EU or US terminology) and set-up of a common glossary
- Phase 4: Streamlining content & Testing
 - Editorial review and corrections of the definitions and assigning transatlantic equivalent terms whenever possible by *EU/US Best Practise Group*
- Phase 5: Public Launch in the US and EU
 - Presentation of *Terminology MediaWiki* and workshops on adding and editing during research administrators and research manager conferences
